- A _____ a transitional question. Ask an open-ended and designed to create discussion about spiritual matters.
 - Ask about jewelry, clothing, tattoos, or anything spiritual they mention at any point. Do you go to church anywhere? What did your faith background look like growing up? Are you pretty religious or not really? Do you like deep questions? Do you mind if I ask you a deep question? Scale 1-10?
- L _____ to what they have to say.
- T _____ the conversation to the gospel.
